A certified copy of a divorce decree is a copy made by an officer of the court where the original document is stored. It is certified by the officer to be a true copy and is often stamped with the embossed seal of the court or state. A certified divorce decree may be necessary for legal matters when proof is required of a final divorce.

Copies of the actual divorce decree can only be obtained from Superior Court in the county where the divorce took place. How to Obtain a Certificate of Record for a Divorce

It is signed by the judge and filed with the County Clerk, usually in the County where the plaintiff resided. To get a copy of a divorce decree, contact the County Clerk. If the divorce was granted before January 1, 1963, the divorce decree is the only type of document available.

The Divorce Judgment Document Order site allows the public to order copies of divorce judgments without having to visit the Archives and Records Center (ARC). If your Family Law judgment is not available on-line, and if you are requesting a case that had a court hearing on or after January 2, 2018, the document may be available through the Court's Case Document Images link.
