When president Suharto left office in May 1998 it marked the beginning of a new period in Indonesian history. After being ruled by Suharto's authoritarian New Order regime for over three decades, Indonesia embarked for a new phase called Reformation (Reformasi in Indonesian). It was envisaged to be the starting period of a democracy with open and liberal politics in which extensive autonomy would be transferred to the regions, away from the center (decentralization).
